Study Purpose

The purpose of this study is to develop an Overall Transportation Plan for the City of Georgetown, which will include recommended transportation improvements needed to accommodate travel demands through the Year 2025. An implementation program that prioritizes the recommended Plan improvements will also be developed and include a short-range (2003 to 2007), intermediate-range (2008 to 2013), and long-range (2013 to 2025) program. Potential highway improvements to be considered include roadway widenings and/or extensions, bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure, and transit options.

Study Objectives

The following study objectives were developed by the Technical Advisory Committee and the Stakeholders Focus Group at the beginning of this project. The Overall Transportation Plan will strive to meet the following objectives:

- Improve and increase safety
- Consider the impacts of State Highway 130
- Incorporate bicycle and pedestrian elements
- Create an interconnected system addressing all modes and capacity issues
- Connect the City's trail system with sidewalks and roads
- Coordinate with transit service and the planned regional commuter rail
- Protect neighborhoods and quality of life
- Connect land use and transportation
- Preserve right-of-way for long range capacity
- Enhance corridors and gateways
